



POP-UPs for ID and passport controls to be conducted in December 2023 at the Honorary Consulate in Sao Paulo

On November 1 2022, the Swedish Migration Agency introduced new procedures for stricter ID and passports controls in connection with applications for residence permits. Since November 1, all applicants of a residence permit are required to visit the Embassy of Sweden in Brasilia in-person, before the Swedish Migration Agency can grant a decision on the application.

To make ID and passport controls more accessible for student and work permit applicants of Brazilian citizenship, or other visa exempt citizen, Swedish authorities have decided to provide POP-UP ID and passport controls at the Honorary Consulate in Sao Paulo on December 6 and 7, 2023. These POP-UP ID and passport controls will be conducted by officials from the Swedish Migration Agency along with staff from the Embassy of Sweden in Brasilia.

Important Notice

POP-UP ID and passport controls are only applicable for Brazilian and other visa exempt nationalities residing in Brazil, that have applied for a resident permit for the purpose of studying or working in Sweden.

Applicants of other nationalities and applicants of other types of residence permits (family ties, for example) are not eligible for these POP-UP ID and passport controls. Family tie applicants, still have to visit the Embassy of Sweden in Brasilia to submit their biometrics and conduct an interview before entering Sweden.
