Throughout the programme you develop your own initiative and apply learnings from the programme to continuously develop skills on how to make positive business impact. The programme unites the participants in a long-lasting network focusing on a sustainable future. The programme fee is partly funded by the Swedish Government.

an integral part of your business strategy and to increase your network of like-minded people. When?

The programme timeline expands over a period of nine months and is divided into three parts:

- Module 3 in Africa: Reconnection and learnings from module 1. One week in February 2021.
